

Read Me CERES4.50.02 Web Orders with Zero Quantity (Ceres4.50.02)

Service Request or Support:

Issue addressed: Web Orders with zero quantity do not set Web Order line information correctly. Advancing a Web Order with a zero quantity line to the Order Modifications of Food Bank Only, permits increasing the quantity on such lines however, the Web Order is not able to post because the required fields on the line are not populated.

This issue can occur when a Web Order is initially submitted to Ceres with quantity on all lines and then resubmitted with one or more lines having a zero quantity.

This release does not present a change in system usage methodology.

Resolution: Ceres was enhanced to address the issue by not recreating zero quantity lines. This means that if a given Web Order line has a non-zero line for a given version (submission), and a subsequent version has a zero quantity for that given Web Order line, the line will not appear on the Web Order in Ceres after the Web Order Validation process has been run.
