

Read Me CERES4.51.23 Duplicate Server Instance Name AE Monitoring

(Ceres4.51.23)

Issue addressed: The AE Monitor functionality provides an error code 092 notification when it is found that one of the Job Queues being monitored is running under the same Server Instance Name as the AE Monitor Job Queue itself. This condition can be created manually or when a monitored Job Queue is found to not be in the started state and is then started under AE Monitor Job Queue's assigned Server Instance Name.

While it is best practice to specify a Server Instance Name that is indicative of its purpose (and thus names are unique within an environment), it is possible to have duplicate Server Instance Names when two or more NAV Servers have been configured on two or more machines. In this case, the AE Monitor functionality can report a false error code 092 notification.

This release does not present a change in system usage methodology.

Resolution: Ceres was enhanced to address the reported issue by constricting the conditions under which error code 092 is deemed to exist. This was accomplished by considering the machine names upon which duplicate Server Instances Names exist.
